COURAGEOUS, AND INCREDIBLY LOVING, AS YOU CONSIDER ADOPTION.


We know that you have deeply thought about making the best choice for your child. We pray that you will find peace in your decision and know that you are loved no matter what you choose.






Our Hearts for Adoption

WE HAVE ALWAYS WANTED TO BE PARENTS AND OUR JOURNEY TO BECOME PARENTS HAS LASTED LONGER THAN WE EXPECTED. After years of not becoming pregnant, we sought out help from a fertility doctor.

After 3 unsuccessful rounds of IUI procedures, several tests, exploratory procedures and surgeries, and tons of bloodwork, we were diagnosed with unexplained infertility. Despite this diagnosis, it was suggested that we try IVF and after 4 failed rounds of a frozen embryo transfer, we paused to re-evaluate our situation.





Adoption was something that we have always been aware of, but we were not aware of the beauty of adoption until we shared our fertility journey with friends and family and learned more about their adoption stories.
