

CCPSL Rule Exceptions

**The following rules will override current 2015 ASA rules during league play. HAC is ASA sanctioned.

1. Women and men can bat in any order.
2. A woman will not get an automatic walk if the man batting before her walks.
3. The following scenarios will determine if a team can play or forfeit:
 - 1 roster player = forfeit
 - 2 roster players = forfeit
 - 3 roster players = forfeit
 - 4 roster players = forfeit
 - 5 roster players = forfeit
 - 6 roster players = forfeit
 - 7 roster players = minimum requirement to borrow two players
 - I. A team must have a minimum of two roster women to play.
 - a. A team may borrow one man and one woman to make nine.
 - b. A team may borrow two women to make nine.
 - c. A team cannot borrow two men to make nine.
 - II. There is no league minimum on the number of men a team must field.
 - 8 roster players = minimum requirement to borrow one player (man or woman)
 - I. After the 10-minute grace period, if both teams have only eight players, then a double forfeit will be called.
 - II. If within the 10-minute grace period, a 9th player shows for Team A, the game will start.
 - III. The 9th player for Team B must show by the end of the first inning, or 6th out, or Team B must forfeit the game.
 - 9 roster players = league minimum
 - I. A player may not be borrowed to make 10.
 - 10 roster players = a full team
 - I. At least three roster women must be fielded.
 - II. No more than seven roster men can be fielded.
4. A team may add players to its roster during the regular season only, not during the tournament. If a team does not have nine roster players, the team must forfeit the game. Players may be added to the roster up until the last weekend of the regular season. Players had to play in a regular season game to be eligible for tournament play.
5. A player cannot appear on two or more team rosters.
6. If the ball beats the runner to home plate, the runner must avoid contact or attempt to slide.
7. 60-minute timed games regardless of injuries or 10-minute grace period.
8. A team may use up to two courtesy runners per game; they must be the same gender as the hitter. If the courtesy runner is on base when their spot in the lineup comes to bat, the batter is out.
9. Run Rule: 20 runs after 3 innings, 15 runs after 4 innings and 10 runs after 5 innings. A complete game is 7 innings.
